This balance includes 22-23 dues from all 3 regions and a \$4200.00 CD Transfer to our checking account. We only have 2 times of the year with expenditures: the TMEA Convention and our upcoming Summer Symposium / Meeting. TBA Website Updates: Susan Waters: Our website needs to be updated with current information.

Marching Band: Joel Denton: We have discussed having a judges' manual for the past several years. Our TBA Marching Band Scoring Forms have been requested for use by others. I sent an email to members of our association who are interested in serving on a manual committee. I realize that we have contests across our state that are sponsored by bands who cannot afford national judges. We want to see our band programs to exhibit growth...a musically driven activity driven by everything else (visuals...ect.). We need to get our manual approved and then we can sanction events. I recommend that we ask Barry Trobaugh to be in charge of sanctioning our TBA marching band shows. Jeff Beckman: This sanctioning has become very important. possibilities: editing pieces that haven't been played in many years, fanfares and marches which have not been removed...etc.
